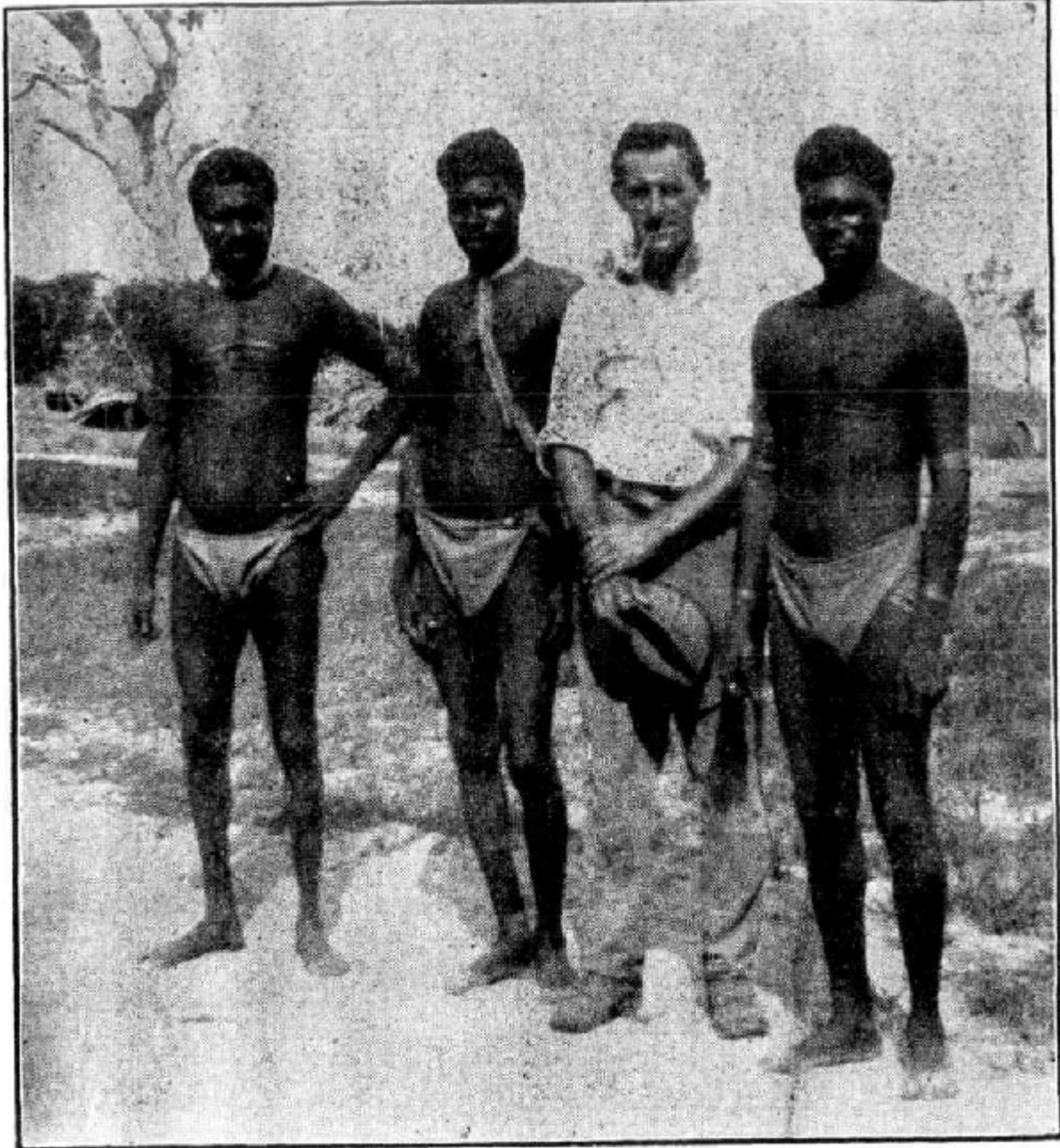
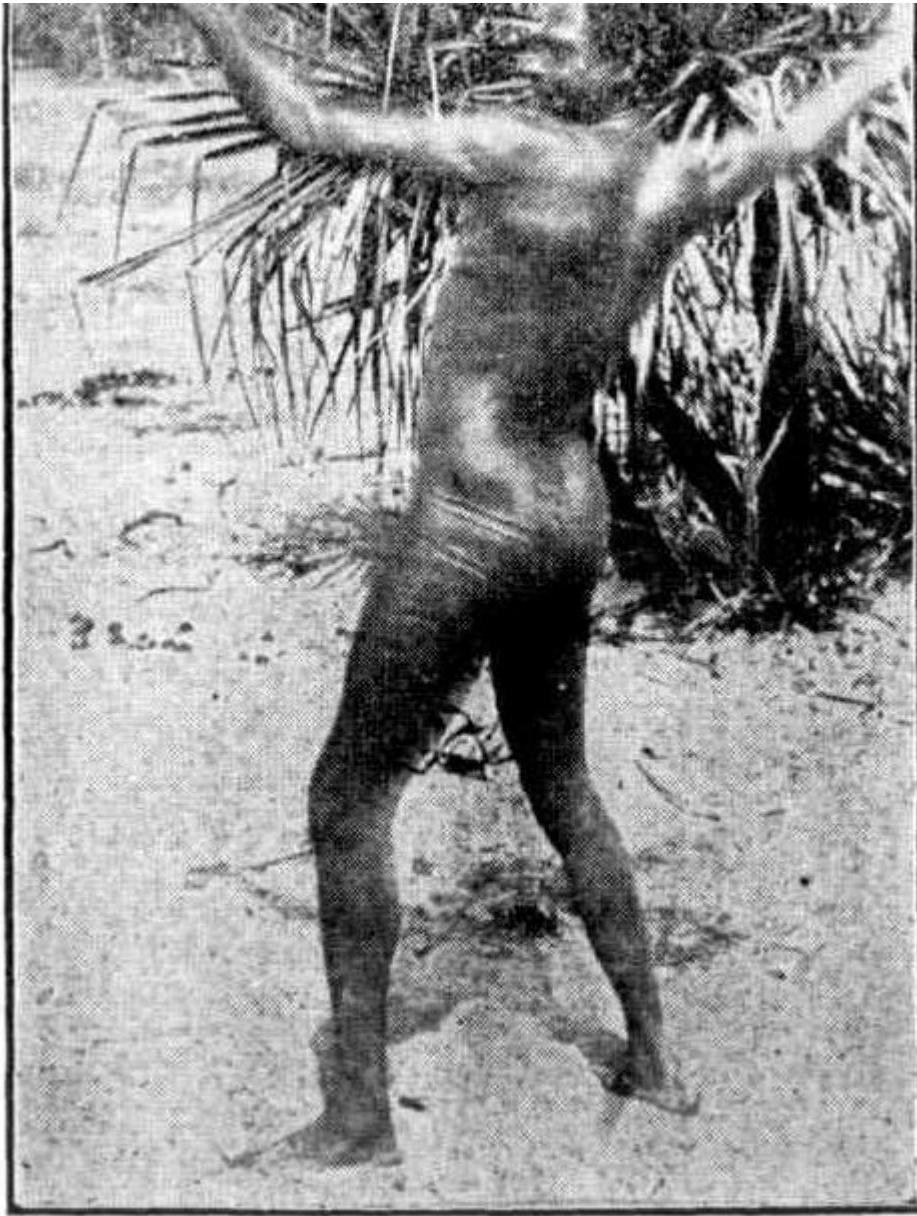


## MISSIONARY'S ASSISTANT SPEARED.

Webb, at Crocodile Island, Northern Territory, on February 13, 1927, and wounded. Three natives were found guilty at Darwin last week in connection with the attack.
